# Funding

- Property Tax
- Highway Tax Distribution
  - Based on the collections of motor vehicle registrations, fuel taxes, use taxes and special fuels excise tax.
     Distributed monthly to counties and cities.

#### Highway Tax Distribution & Costs 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter 2020

- Counties: \$7,084,823.58

   Equates to \$129.16 per mile
- Townships: \$5,419,241.60 - Equates to \$128.98 per mile
- State Wide Average Costs
  - Graveling (2" or 560 ton): \$9,500 \$18,200 per mile
  - Chip Sealing: \$30,000 \$35,000 per mile
  - Paving: \$100,000 \$110,000 per inch per mile
  - Box Culvert: @ \$400,000 for a mid size box
  - Bridge Replacement: \$175/SF \$225/SF

Regulates how we perform our duties

- Powers and duties
  - Design or make plans for county/township roads.
  - Comprehensive plan.
  - Keep complete record of costs and expenditures.
  - Check all accounts, claims and demands for expenditures with all matters and indicate recommendation prior to submission of accounts, claims and demands to the board of commissioners.

#### **Powers and Duties**

- Keep a complete inventory of all equipment.
- Supervise the use of all county-owned road equipment and materials.
- Employ and supervise all other personnel engaged in county road operations, terminating such employment when required in the best interest of the county.

- Powers and duties

  - Highway departments must keep a complete inventory of repairs, gasoline and oil, and miscellaneous items.

- Powers and duties

  - Highway superintendents or engineers must prepare and submit an annual report.

- Powers and duties
  - TRUE
  - Highway superintendents or engineers must prepare and submit to the board of county commissioners a complete yearly report and such additional reports as may be required by the board of county commissioners at any time.

#### **Powers and Duties**

- Cooperate with the public roads administration or successors, the state department of transportation, and the townships of the county.
- Perform such other duties as may be designated by the board of commissioners.

#### County Road – NDCC 24-05

- This chapter regulates HOW we do our jobs
  - It covers items like: County Road Taxes Allocation and Use, Payments for Completed Work, Contracts, Leasing Equipment, Right-of-Way, Responsibility for County Road System, Road Grades and Ditches, Pest Control, Intersections, Inslopes, Encroachments and Liabilities, and Removal of Obstructions in Right-of-Way.

# Did you know?

- NDCC 36-14-20 states it's the duty of the overseer of highways when carcass of dead animal is found.
  - If the owner or person in charge of a dead animal fails to comply with 36-14-19, the overseer of highways shall comply with the provisions of section 36-14-19 for the owner or person. Costs associated with the disposal can be charged to the owner.
